Glacier view point.









IMPORTANT

Some important points to bear in mind

- This is a hiking and trekking tour with some long drives. We do
 not recommend it for those looking for a gentle sightseeing
 tour. We have other options for those who prefer a gentle tour
 with hiking and adventure.
- The tour has short rides on some days while there are days when you have to cover a long distance, the road surface is smooth in some places while it is bumpy in some sections.
- We cannot and do not want to offer a uniform standard of accommodation on our itineraries. When choosing accommodationwe look at comfort, location, design, character, historical interest and whether the money we spend goes into the pockets of the locacommunity. We offer standard accommodation that is neat, clean and simple.
- There is an energy crisis all over the country, especially in the mountains. Sometimes the lights go out at night and it takes a whfor the emergency power supply to switch back on. We advise you have a torch and a power bank with you just in case.
- Due to power cuts, which is not always the case, the hot shower may not be available during the night while you are in the mountains, but you will have a hot shower the next morning because it takes time to prepare with alternative energy sources.



IMPORTANT

Some important points to bear in mind

- Sometimes participants ask for amenities such as hair dryers in the hotels, while most hotels in the north do not have hair dryers in the washroom, possibly due to an electricity crisis.
 Please make your own arrangements if you need one.
- If the trip takes place in spring or autumn, you will need warm clothes such as a jumper, jacket and good walking shoes, especially if you have to hike.
- On this trip you will be accompanied by a local, Englishspeaking guide from Ultimate Adventure Tours. Sometimes we
 also hire local guides in different sections. If we are a large
 group, we can split into smaller groups for the tours to allow
 more flexibility.
